

ChemE Chair search update (Di Xiao, MSE Chair)

- The discussion to nominate a new ChemE chair continues to be discussed at the highest levels of the department and COE
 - o A committee has been formed to drill down into the possible candidates
 - List to follow
- Job ad should be posted on February 7th; March to April Candidate interviews; late April to May: Final report submitted to Dean of COE

ABET (the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology) update (Adler)

- Accreditation is coming down the road for next Fall
 - o From now until June: Collect site visit materials
 - o July: Site materials need to be posted in final form
 - o Summer: Program evaluation reviews self-study and online document
- Who does this apply to?
 - o Applies to all UG courses, bot just those used for embedded assessment
 - o All core courses and common electives used to satisfy ChemE degree
 - Point of contact will be Andrea
- Required course documents
 - Syllabus: Must have topic breakdown and instructional objectives
 - Sample of instructional materials given to students (1 of each type)
 - Samples of graded student work (1 of each type)
- Overarching curricular materials
 - Process hazards
 - Molecular and nanoscale principles

 - UG course with embedded ABET assessments

 - Rubric with descriptions and definition, a qualitative description of work; DO
 NOT used numerical/point-based rubric for rubric
 - Use group assignments to assess student attainment -- use qualitative language based on performance indicators; DO NOT based on aggregate student effort

Universal Design for Learning teaching tips (Prybutok)

Using Team Contracts to give TA's a strong foundation!

- Goals: Ensure teams set communication and behaviors standards before assignments begin to minimize issues down the line.
- Method: Ask students to fill out a team contract and set goals
