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Universal Design in Learning teaching tips (Prybutok)

- 1st: Use Team Peer Evaluation to assess teams and create open communications about the areas of growth.
 - o Goals: Give all students an equal chance to voice what they think is going well and what could improve.
 - o Method: CATME can help set up the peer evaluations
- 2nd: Create documents in accessible formats for a screen reader
 - Goal: Ensure students with disabilities can access courses content, meet DOJ requirements
 - o Method: It's generally easier to create accessible documents from the start.

The University's response to funding issues (Carothers)

- There is a lot happening in the background: Provost x COE ExComm is working together to sort this; AAU and Big Ten on issues impacting research at the University
- UW working with WA State Attorney General on all relevant Executive Orders and Agency Directives
- We will receive instructions on what we necessarily have to do...

Department Budget and Funding

- The UW faces a "convergence" of federal and state budget cuts
 - o Faculty hiring; Ph.D. admissions; Staff hiring
 - o No searches, offers are being rescinded, money is being clawed back
 - o Other cost containment measures are being implemented (refer to slide deck)
 - o Comprehensive dialogue regarding potential budget contingencies for graduate students, staff, research and others.
 - o ChemE continues to develop a measured approach to solve these complex budgetary concerns.
